# Working Rustic

*An Introduction to Creating With Natural Materials*

In this workshop, Daniel Mack introduces us to the basic construction techniques and tools of rustic work, and guides us as we learn by working on our own projects. During the workshop, we can expect to finish at least two projects. Chairs and benches are popular, but some people prefer mobiles, stick animals, and other sculptural approaches to the materials. (Plan ahead on how to transport them home.)

Excellent for people who have never used a drill or a hammer, this workshop will also surprise and challenge experienced builders and craftspeople as they encounter the subtleties of the rustic ways of making things.
